Essential CBE Instructional Components



Flex scheduling and choice hubs give students options to earn credits outside of the traditional day. Students personalize their schedules to advance their academic and career goals at a pace that works for their learning style.



Learner profiles provide all students with up-to-date information on their progress towards mastery. Every student takes ownership of their learning by providing evidence of what they've absorbed and getting feedback through one-on-one meetings with teachers.



Project-based learning and performance tasks create custom learning paths for students.

Teachers and students work together to adapt these learning plans based on student needs, interests, and goals.



Student performance is assessed based on specific and observable skills to ensure readiness.

Challenge: Advance personalized learning across the district through CBE.

Customized Support: Johnston County Public Schools partnered with RTI to refine their learning framework and scale CBE across the district. Support focused on expanding implementation in four key areas: learner profiles, personal learning paths, standards-based teaching and learning, and flexible learning environments.

Results: All elementary schools are now implementing standards-based grading in grades K-4. Five schools are implementing staged CBE.
