

Recognize. Elevate. Compensate. Texas Teacher Incentive Allotment (TIA)

The Opportunity: Build a District-Wide Program to Increase Teacher Compensation

Texas House Bill 3 provides funding for districts to create a performance-based compensation system designed to recruit and retain top teacher talent in classrooms. Qualifying districts will receive additional funding for every teacher designated as master, exemplary, or recognized. Teachers in rural and/or highneed schools are eligible for the largest increases.

Core Beliefs

Teachers are the single-greatest in-school factor influencing student outcomes. RTI's Center for Education Services and Safal Partners—two national leaders in educational innovation—are seeking to partner with driven districts that are committed to recognizing, elevating, and compensating excellent teaching and that share these four core beliefs:

- Great teaching is the lifeblood of excellent schools.
- 2 Teaching quality should be assessed with a rich set of measures.

 - Compensation matters for recruitment and retention.

Our Partnering Approach

We will use a strategic co-design process to help districts plan and implement a TIA–aligned teacher designation system and secure state funding to compensate classroom excellence.

Phase I: Plan and Prepare


Objectives: Agree on co-designed goals; **develop** vision for district system; **explore** aligned measures; **gather** stakeholder input; **finalize** pilot model with designations; and **communicate** relentlessly.

Phase II: Launch and Designate

Objectives: Launch operational compensation system; **manage** implementation; **adjust** practices to strengthen model; **designate** and **compensate** first cohort of master, exemplary, and recognized teachers; and **communicate** relentlessly.
